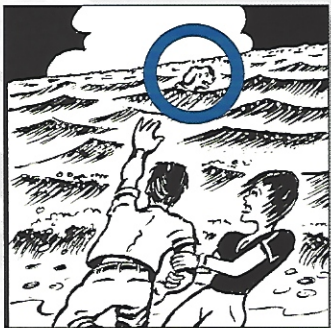

1 Never turn your back on the ocean



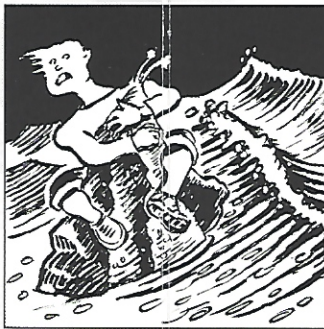
4 Rocks can be slippery
